# SUMMARY OF COMMITTEES

## Hospitality

Members who arrive a little earlier to our monthly meetings to set up and organize food and drinks that everyone brings for lunch and fellowship after the meeting.

#### **Spiritual Life**

Members who are interested in leading devotions during our meetings. This is typically done on a rotational basis and referred to as "Ohana" time.

#### **Finance**

Members who are committed to responsible stewardship of our organization's finances and may have knowledge or experience with budgets. Attends meetings as scheduled by our Finance Committee Chair.

#### **Missions**

Members who have a strong desire to be involved in identifying organizations and ministries that our WBM may potentially support or partner with. Attends meetings as scheduled by our Missions Committee Chair.

#### **Nominating**

Members who represent the best interests of our membership by nominating other available members to serve in various positions, who are then voted on by our Cabinet and Council.

#### **Membership**

Members who are particularly interested in promoting growth in our membership and finding ways to keep our members connected. Attends Membership Committee meetings as scheduled by our Membership Chair.

#### **Annual Meeting**

Members who assist in planning and coordinating this event with our WBM President and Executive Director.

#### **Family Thank Offering**

Members who review requests received for emergency financial assistance through our WBM one-time mission grants for families or individuals experiencing hardship or great need. Requests may include assistance with rent, utilities, food, and other basic necessities. Members are contacted by our Family Thank Offering Committee Chair when requests are received.

### **InTouch Ministry**

Members who make compassionate and courtesy calls to other members who are ill, have been absent from meetings consecutively, and/or as directed by calling rosters and schedules. This is done with the understanding that outreach extends to our very own members.

#### **Special Projects**

Members who participate in various outreach projects. One example is visitations to our homeless population in the parks to take gifts of basic necessities and food while sharing the love of God. Special projects are guided by our Missions Committee Chair.

#### **Personnel Committee**

The Personnel Committee is an ad hoc group of current and active WBM members who are appointed by the WBM Cabinet. They are responsible for drafting and/or revising personnel policies for board approval, reviewing job descriptions, and providing a yearly review of the executive director, her job description, and salary on a yearly basis.
