- All who attend must register by May 04, 2020. All local church delegates for AHEC, SCHCC, SSSA and CE-HI (Partnership Ministries) meetings should register all their delegates using one form per person. The registration fee is \$125 per person. Please make checks payable to Hawai'i Conference UCC and mail payment(s) to be received by the deadline of May 04, 2020. (Please note that the deadline for the 'Aha Makua registration is the same.)
- Retired Pastors who previously served our Hawaiian churches will have their registration fees for the 'Aha Iki waived. Housing costs and air reservations are on your own.

Housing:

A block of rooms has been reserved at the Pagoda Hotel (1525 Rycroft St., Honolulu). Transportation:

Airlines:

Delegates and visitors are responsible for booking their own flight reservations and making payments accordingly. Please schedule your flights to arrive in Honolulu between 7:30am and 8:15am. Last shuttle is scheduled to leave the airport at 8:15am.

If you are only attending the 'Aha Iki, and plan to leave on Thursday, June 04, 2020, Please schedule your departure on the last flight to your home island that evening.

Shuttle:

Vans will be scheduled for arrival pick-ups at the Daniel K. Inouye Airport on Wednesday, June 03, 2020 and for departure drop-offs on Thursday, June 04, 2020. If ground transportation is required (for arrival / departure), please complete the transportation section on the registration form and return the completed form by May 04, 2020, to the Hawaii Conference UCC office. Shuttle service will be scheduled to meet only the flights for which "arrival and departure" transportation is requested.

Arrivals: When you arrive, go to the Hawaiian Airlines baggage claim area and pick up your baggage; exit the baggage claim area and look for a van with a "Hawai'i Conference UCC" sign. Give the driver your name, so your name can be checked against the passenger list the driver will have. **Please be patient if the van is not at the airport when you arrive.**

Delegate Authorization:

AHEC

- 1. Each church shall be represented by two (2) lay delegates and a youth delegate who is thirty years of age or less at the time of meeting. Churches with more than one hundred (100) members shall be entitled to one (1) delegate for each additional fifty (50) or major fraction thereof. The total delegates from any one church shall not exceed seven (7).
- 2. All Kahu, the Conference Minister of the Hawai'i Conference, members of the Board of Directors, representatives of recognized Partnership Ministries and Chairpersons of Standing Committees shall represent themselves.

SCHCC

- 1. An active member church shall be entitled to one lay delegate. Churches having more than 200 members shall be entitled to elect one additional lay delegate for each additional 100 members, up to a total of five delegates.
- 2. Each active member church shall also be entitled to elect one youth/young adult delegate, thirty years of age or younger.
- 3. One authorized minister (ordained, licensed or commissioned) from each active member church.

NOTE: A Makeke has traditionally been the annual fundraiser for the SCHCC, however, rather than having a "physical Makeke", monetary donations will be gratefully accepted.
